Implementation Plan



- Spring 2012
 - Meet with Apple to Explore Options

 - Communicate the Plan / Build Support (i.e. School Improvement Team, BOE, Community Organizations, etc.)
- Summer 2012
 - Provide Teachers with a MacBook Pro & Training (prior to summer break in June)
 - Select Teachers to attend Summer Training / Create a "Teacher Tech Team" (i.e. Intel, Cary Academy, Apple, etc.)
 - Hire a Technology Facilitator

Implementation Plan



- Fall 2012
 - Upgrade Wireless Network / Setup a HELP Desk
 - Continuously Study the Staff Development Plan / Setup PLCs / Provide Teachers with Staff Development (i.e. Best Practices, Blackboard/Moodle, etc.)
 - Develop Deployment Plan / Prepare Laptops for Students
 - Explore "Protection Insurance"
 - Develop & Communicate AUP to Teachers, Students, & Parents (specifically addressing the 1-to-1 program)
 - Provide Internet Safety Courses for all Students
 - Train a Cohort of Students to serve as "Tech Support"

Implementation Plan



- Spring 2013
 - Deploy Laptops to Students (Laptops are checked-out in January following a parent meeting and returned in June!)
 - Continue Professional Development for Teachers, Continue Operating the HELP Desk, & Evaluating/Reflecting on the Program
- Summer 2013
 - Continue Staff Development
 - Clean and Prepare Student Laptops for Re-Deployment
 - Reflect and Evaluate
