## 7610 PRE-AUDIT CERTIFICATION

<u>Except as otherwise provided by law, n</u>No obligation may be incurred by the school system unless the budget resolution includes an appropriation authorizing the obligation and an unencumbered balance remains in the appropriation sufficient to pay in the current fiscal year the sums obligated by the transaction for the current fiscal year.

<u>If an obligation is evidenced by reduced to a written contract or written</u> agreement requiring the payment of money or <u>is evidenced by</u> a purchase order for supplies and materials, the <u>written</u> contract, agreement, or purchase order shall include on its face a certificate stating that the instrument has been pre-audited to assure compliance with <u>state law</u> this policy. The certificate, which shall be signed by the school finance officer, shall take substantially the following form:

"This instrument has been pre-audited in the manner required by the School Budget and Fiscal Control Act.

\_\_\_\_\_(Signature of school finance officer) \_\_\_\_\_\_ (Date)"

No pre-audit certificate is required for (1) an obligation, or a document related to the obligation, that has been approved by the Local Government Commission; (2) payroll expenditures, including employee benefits; or (3) electronic payments, upon adoption of and in compliance with rules adopted by the Local Government Commission.

An obligation incurred in violation of <u>the requirements of state law as specified in</u> this policy is invalid and may not be enforced. The school finance officer shall establish procedures <u>in</u> <u>accordance with any rules adopted by the Local Government Commission</u> to assure compliance with <u>statutory requirements and</u> this policy.
