TERMS OF PAYMENT:

Initial Group Deposit:

\$500 per group non-refundable deposit and signed contract is due to reserve services. If group fails to materialize, deposit will be transferred to your next group within 24 months of original date, maximum two transfers.

Air Deposit:

\$100 per person within 21 days of confirmation, refundable up to 100 days prior to departure (except where airline terms differ)

Second Deposit:

\$200 Per person due 180 days prior to departure*

*30 days after confirmation for groups that book less than 180 days prior to departure.

Passenger Details:

Passenger Information as follows due 100 days prior to departure:

1. All names as they appear on the passport's in the following format. (LAST NAME / FIRST NAME, MIDDLE NAME)
2. Date of Birth for each passenger
3. Passport Number and Expiration Date
4. Gender
5. Rooming list (if you do not have a final rooming list we need a tentative with specified who will be a single and who will be in a double room)

Cancellation:

Once a partial or full payment has been made, cancellations will only be accepted in writing. Cancellation terms will be applied

based on the date that the written cancellation is received and based on the following dates prior to departure.

Up to 180 days prior to departure: \$500 per group

179 to 101 days prior to departure: \$200 per person

100 to 61 days prior to departure: \$300 per person

60 to 31 days or less prior to departure: 75% of land/cruise services & 100% of air cost

30 days or less prior to departure/ no-show: 100% of all services

FUEL SURCHARGES:

Airlines and cruise-lines retain the right to adjust prices based upon market price fuel surcharges. In those cases, Gate1 will adjust your invoice accordingly. In order to avoid these potential charges, your entire group must be paid in full and airline tickets issued.

CURRENCY FLUCTUATIONS:

All prices are based on current rates of exchange. Your final invoice will reflect any increases resulting from currency fluctuations.

SINGLE OR TRIPLE ACCOMMODATIONS: are limited and subject to availability.

SCHEDULED BUS TOURS:

Due to the limited capacity of our tours, we will periodically review the progress of your sales and reserve the right to recall group space without names and "per-person" deposit at any time, with 7 days notice.

DOCUMENTS:

Charge for paper documents when e-documents are available is \$30 per person. Provided full payment is received no later than your Final Payment Due date, documents will be sent via email 21 days prior to the onset of services. Paper documents, when requested, will be delivered approximately 14-21 days prior to the onset of services. A complete street address is required for mailed documents (no PO boxes).

AIRLINE SEATS:

Seats will be requested per your completed passport name list and confirmed no earlier than 40 days prior to departure. Every airline has different seating policies. For individual airline policies and other relevant information go to <http://www.gate1travel.com/airlinepolicies.htm> Any name change may result in that seat being revoked by the carrier. Bulkhead and exit row seats are considered at airport check-in only. Domestic flights are blocked for group seat requests.

TRAVELERS WITH DISABILITIES:

Tour participants requiring any form of assistance are required to notify Gate 1 Travel in writing at the time of reservation, and must be accompanied by an individual responsible for providing those services. Friday, April 18, 2014- Depart the U.S. for Seville
Depart Norfolk via American Airlines at 2:55 pm arriving in JFK at 4:20 pm. Connect to an American flight departing 6:50 pm arriving the next day in Madrid.

Saturday, April 19, 2014 - Arrive in Seville
Arrive in Madrid at 8:30 am and connect to an Iberia flight departing 11:50 am pm arriving in Seville 1:00 pm. Upon arrival in Seville you will be met and transfer to your hotel for check-in. The balance of the day is free.

Today is a free day to relax on the beach, enjoy shopping or take an optional tour to Tangier. You will drive the length of the Costa del Sol to Algeciras where you will board the ferry to Tangier. Upon crossing the Strait of Gibraltar, you will arrive in Tangier and met by your local guide. You will tour this fascinating city, which is a curious mix of modern buildings in the new part of the city but like stepping onto the past as you walk through the ancient part of the city. You will drive past impressive palaces and villas and passing celebrity homes such as Barbara Hutton and Malcome Forbes (where he once famously gave himself a million dollar birthday party). You will have the opportunity to sit on a camel and may even see a snake charmer. Your tour also visits Hercules Caves, a place of stunning natural beauty and great archaeological significance. This is where the mythical Hercules used to rest after completing his 12 labors. The caves are both natural and man made, but their history is obscured. Then you will tour the old city as you walk through the Kasbah and see life virtually unchanged for hundreds of years. Your visit to Tangier also includes a lunch of famous Moroccan cuisine as you relax to the sounds and sights of musicians and a belly dancer. You will return to the pier to board the boat back to Spain where your waiting bus will return you to your hotel.

Thursday, April 24, 2014 - Full Day Tour of Granada

Today, enjoy a full day tour to Granada. Upon arrival stop in the city center and enjoy time at leisure to walk through the old quarter of Granada and the Alcaiceria. Next, visit the Moorish Alhambra Palace - a hilltop fortress palace of the Nasrid kings, the last Muslim rulers of Spain - is one of the world's fabled landmarks. This monumental edifice is arguably Spain's greatest attraction. Granada came to prominence in the 1200s at the peak of Muslim power. Even after Seville and Córdoba had fallen to the Catholic monarchs, Granada stood as the last surviving Islamic capital in Spain. It's where the sultans took their last stand against the Catholic invaders. You will enjoy a guided tour of the magnificent palace. Continue through the Generalife water gardens from where you can take in a spectacular view of the town and Sierra Nevada Mountains before returning to your hotel in the afternoon.
