Vision: White Oak will engage all stakeholders to create and maintain a superior quality, 21st century, differentiated learning environment where all students grow and thrive.

Mission: At White Oak Elementary School, we will work together as a team to foster a love of learning by providing multiple opportunities for success.

ECPS Goal 1: Edenton-Chowan Schools will create and maintain a healthy, safe, respectful, and responsible educational environment for all students, staff, and parents.

WOS Goals:

- a) All indicators on the SAEBRS (Social, Academic, Emotional Behavior Risk Screener) will be 20% or less.
- b) White Oak Elementary will implement the “buzz in” system at the front door.

ECPS Goal 2: Every student in the Edenton-Chowan School System will graduate from high school prepared t for work, further education, and citizenship.

WOS Goals:

- a) All students will participate in at least one activity that promotes the vision to graduate from high school.

ECPS Goal 3: Every student in Edenton-Chowan Schools will receive a personalized education.

WOS Goals:

- a) White Oak Elementary will increase the proficiency rate of each grade level in Reading*, Math, and Writing by 3% or be at 85% or higher. *New assessment in reading in 2018-19.
- b) All teachers will meet or exceed growth in Reading*. *New assessment in reading in 2018-19.

ECPS Goal 4: Edenton-Chowan Schools will employ and maintain a highly qualified professional and classified staff.

WOS Goals:

- a) Achieved a teacher attendance rate of 95% or higher annually.
- b) All teachers and IAs will participate in a professional learning community.

WOS Goals:
